Cutting Plants

Take cuttings from healthy plants and keep fresh by immersing cut ends in water or by wrapping the stems in a wet cloth until they are ready to be dipped into Root It $^{\text{TM}}$. Make diagonal cuts to stems. Stem ends can be re-cut prior to dipping into Root It $^{\text{TM}}$. Do not keep cuttings in a closed container for an extended period of time. To prevent excessive wilting during the rooting phase, spray the stems frequently with water, cover with moist cheesecloth, or cover with a humidity dome.

Application Instructions

Dip the cut end of the stem into Root It™ for 3 to 5 seconds. Stems can be dipped individually or in bunches. Dip only the part of the plant that is to be placed into a rooting medium. After Root It™ has been applied; place the cutting into a rooting medium.

Depending on the species, rooting can take days, weeks, or months. Transplant cuttings once they are rooted. Root It™ may not work on some species of plants; therefore, experimentation may be necessary to ensure efficacy.
